




- was introduced April 2008

- As of today ... 3460 Assurers have done it :-)

What has all this got to do with Assurance?

For many reasons, it is essential that we are all in this together!

Therefore, the Assurance Policy includes: *A Wider Purpose!*



The Assurance Policy says:

1 - Assurance Purpose



The purpose of Assurance is to add confidence in the Assurance Statement made by the CAcert Community of a Member.

. . .



Section 1.1. - The Assurance Statement

The Assurance Statement makes the following claims about a person:



The 5-Finger-Rule

- Member
- Account
- Certificate
- Arbitration
- Data





1. Member


The person is a bona fide Member.
In other words, the person is a member of the CAcert Community as defined by the CAcert Community Agreement (CCA)





2. Account

The Member has a (login) account with CAcert's on-line registration and service system





3. Certificate

The Member can be determined from any CAcert certificate issued by the Account





4. Arbitration
The Member is bound into
CAcert's Arbitration
as defined by the
CAcert Community Agreement





5. Data

Some personal details of the Member are known to CAcert:

- the individual Name(s),
- primary and other listed individual email address(es),
- secondary distinguishing feature (e.g. DoB)



The Assurer checks all 5 things!

In making the "Assurance Statement" to add confidence in the Web-of-Trust.

Community is four new fingers



d. The CCA and the Assurer







CCA is an abbreviation and stands for

CAcert Community Agreement



Agreement to the CCA means:

→ We are part of a Community

Members, Assurers, all...

→ all are equal

including CAcert Inc., Arbitrators, Auditor

• we may RELY on certificates

and, beyond...



CCA specifies R/L/O

- Risks: bad cert, bad security
- Liabilities: to 1000 euros

also, points, events, ... "foreign courts"

Obligations: security, principles, ...



exciting legal stuff:

Law of NSW Australia

"english common law"

the Arbitration clause (short, paraphrased)

"We agree that all disputes shall be

resolved by Arbitration under DRP"

- terminate: by Arbitration
- must maintain email address

How CCA relates to the Assurance



Agreement is created by:

"your signature on a form to request assurance of identity ("CAP" form),"

New CAP form has it, old does not. So check it:

- CAP form has the request
- Member has requested Assurance

How CCA relates to the Assurance



Agreement is also created by:

"your request on the website to join the Community and create an account,"

Check these:

- Member has account
- confirm email address is primary







The main difference



To the Assurer: The CAcer Assurance Programme (CAP) aims to verify the identifies of internet users through face-fa-face whresing of government issued identify documents. The Applicant asks you to verify to Cacher, on that you have not them and verified their identify against one or more original, trutted, government shoot identify documents. If you have ANY doubts or concerns about the Applicants identify, DO NOT COMPLETE OR BIGNI this form. For more internation about the CAcert Assurance Programme, Including detailed guides for CAcert Assurance programme, including detailed guides for CAcert Assurance programme.

As the assurer, you are required to keep the signed document on file for 7 years. Should Cacert inc. have any concerns about a meeting taking place. Cacert inc. can request proof, in the form of this signed document, to ensure the process is being followed correctly. After 7 years if you wish to dispose of this form it's preferred that you shred and burn it. You do not need to retain copies of ID at all.

It's encouraged that you tear the top of this form off and give it to the person you are assuring as a reminder to sign up, and as a side benefit the tear off section also contains a method of offline verification of our fingerprints.

Principle of reduction:

- You may reduce information
 IdDox ==> CAP Form ==> online system
- Never increase information
- the full Name from IdDox either re-copy it, or add notes
- Multiple IdDox ==> write different names



Specific Rules:


- Transliteration
- Umlaut to ASCII is possible
- ASCII to Umlaut is forbidden
- UPPER/lower case is not significant
- Allow only what is in the document
- Record differences with notes







The Signature

- The Assurer isn't a graphologist so a simple procedure is needed
- The Member has to sign before the Assurer if already signed, ask for another
- Compare the signatures ... and comment
- Easier to forge a signature at home
- Easier to do any squiggle
- Not easy to do both....



The Signature

CAcert Ruling

- Signatures if not exactly comparable can be verified against other, actual documents (i.e. Bank card, credit card)
- Its better to ask for additional documents than ask the Assuree to sign identical to the shown document!

Identification Documents



Homework

What documents can you expect?

- By location
 - Where are you going?
 - Whom can you expect to meet there?
 - What are they likely to have?
- By appointment
 - Ask the assuree

Homework

Where to get info about (unfamiliar) documents and their security features?

- Request it from your government
- Visit a customs or immigration office
- Search the Web
- Ask other Assurers (note privacy...)

Can be done before, during, after the meeting



Be cautious

Many sources are weak Check many places

Bottom line: reduce points for less confidence

"Standard" is at least one:

- Government-issued
- Photo IdDox

Ask for more IdDox




Compare the info IdDox ↔ CAP form

Name – all letters, in full

remember the Principle of Reduction write it out in full if needed

Date of Birth


many different formats ordering can differ you can always ask



Tips

- Check the expiry date
 - does not invalidate the info
- Record the type
 - issuing authority, country
- Write it out again
 - in full, if needed any errors can kill it

- Is photo affixed to or integrated?
- signs of tampering?



- Person ← Photo
- A striking similarity?
- Check issue date...



- Check security features.
 - Stamps
 - Watermarks
 - UV features
 - Relief print
 - Holograms
 - Kinegrams
- Note what you find
- use a UV lamp...
- signs of tampering?





- Advanced features
 - Some lines are not!
 Hidden texts... (AU)
 - Copy of photo (D, AU)
 - Perforated copy of photo (NL)
 - Other?
- Note what you find
- signs of tampering?



Unfamiliar Documents

Surprise! IdDox can be

rare, unfamiliar, strange, inappropriate, useless, false, fraudulent, dubai-ous....



Don't Panic!

"These documents are unfamiliar to me"

Unfamiliar Documents

- Don't Panic!

 "These documents
 are unfamiliar to me"
- Verify what you can
- record the features
- postpone the decision
- do homework later



Unfamiliar documents

• Recall the Purpose of Assurance: Your confidence in your Assurance Statement

AP says:

less points if less confidence ZERO points if ZERO confidence.

If Negative Confidence

carry on collect the evidence file a dispute...

Rough Guide

If the very first time, and

it feels like a real document (it's like one you already know) security features are found research checks out

allocate half points

Unfamiliar documents

Whatever happens...

Inform the assuree

"These documents are unfamiliar to me. I will have to research them. I may allocate less points."

It is your statement...

The Community is RELYING on you!
